PUFFIN CAME,

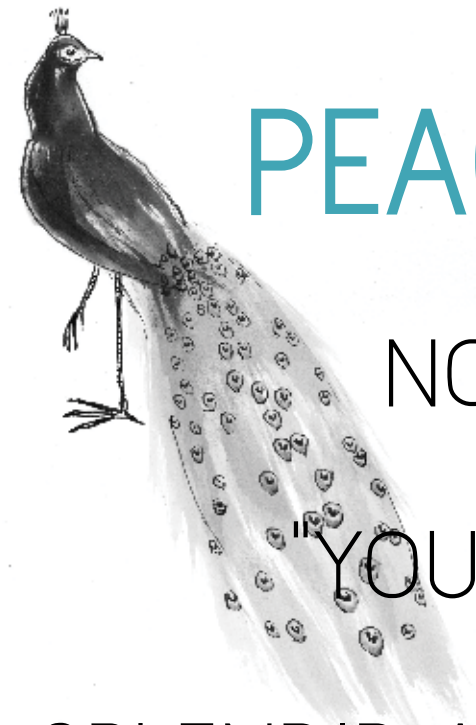
FUNNY AND JOYFUL:

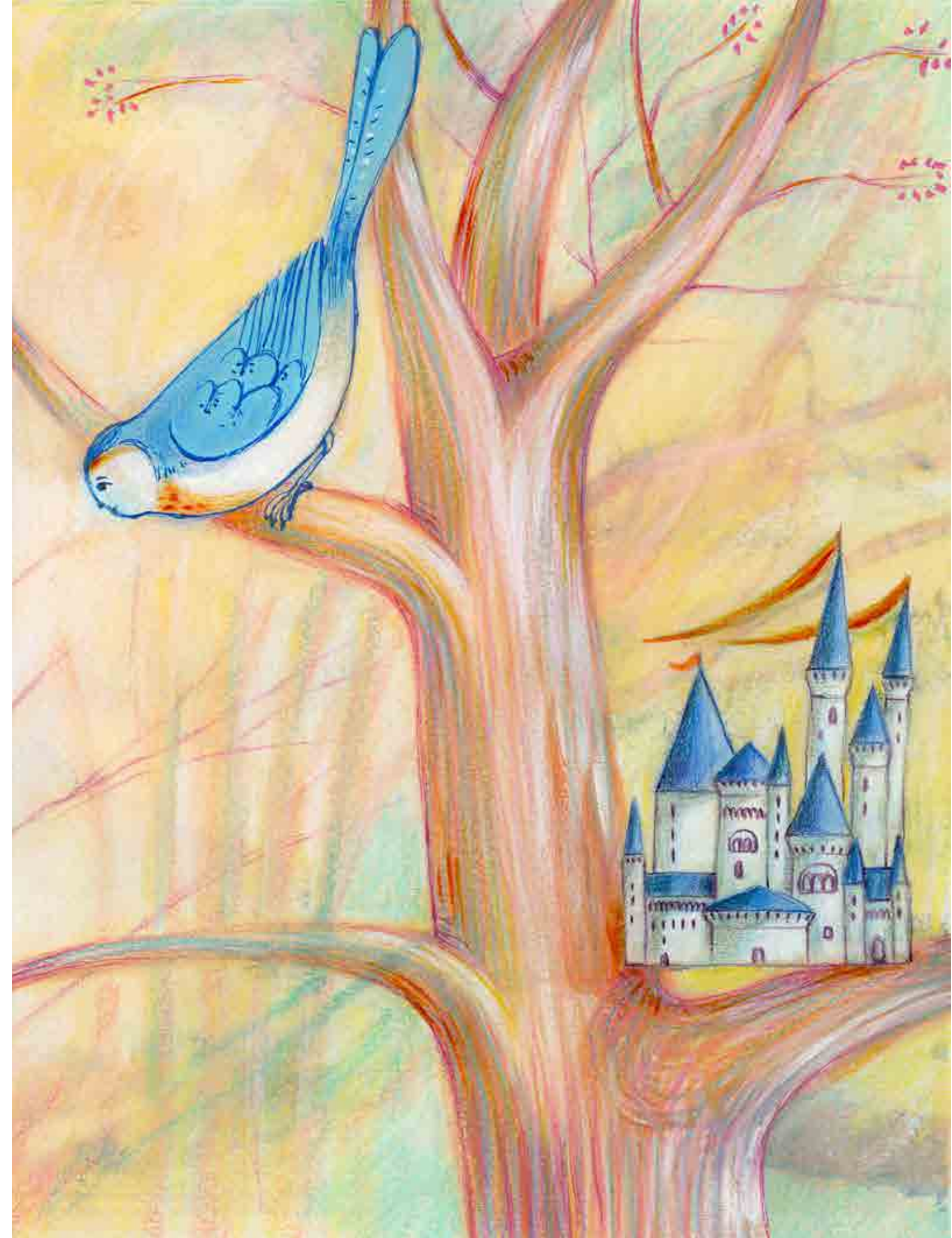




PEACOCK CAME,

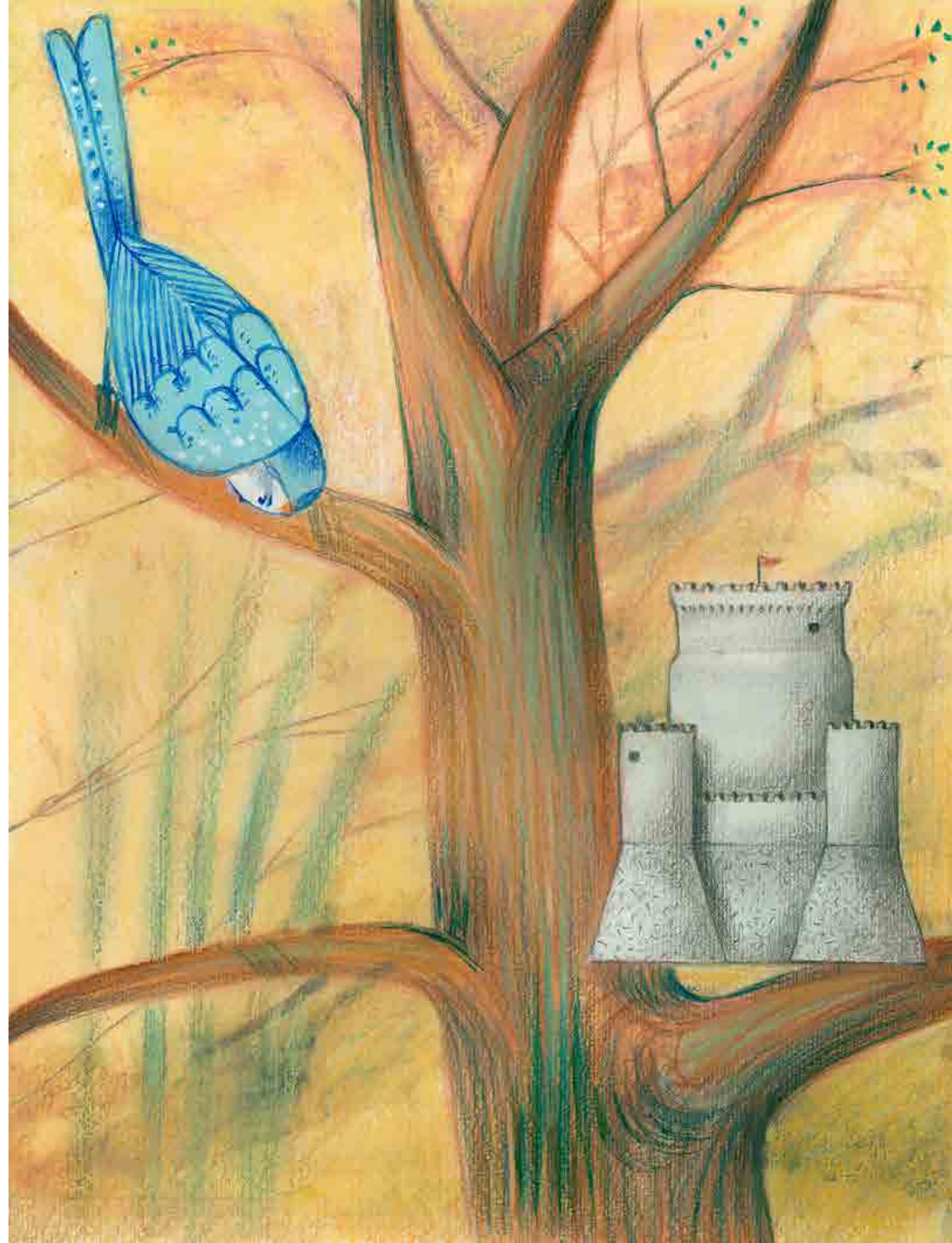

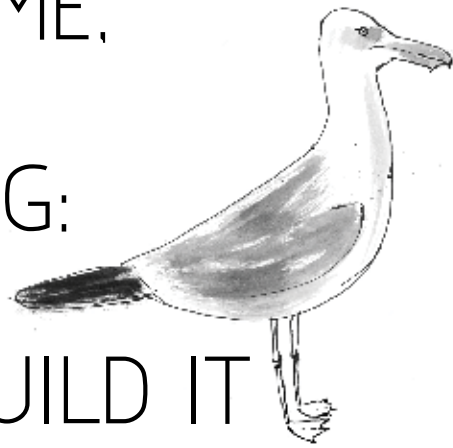

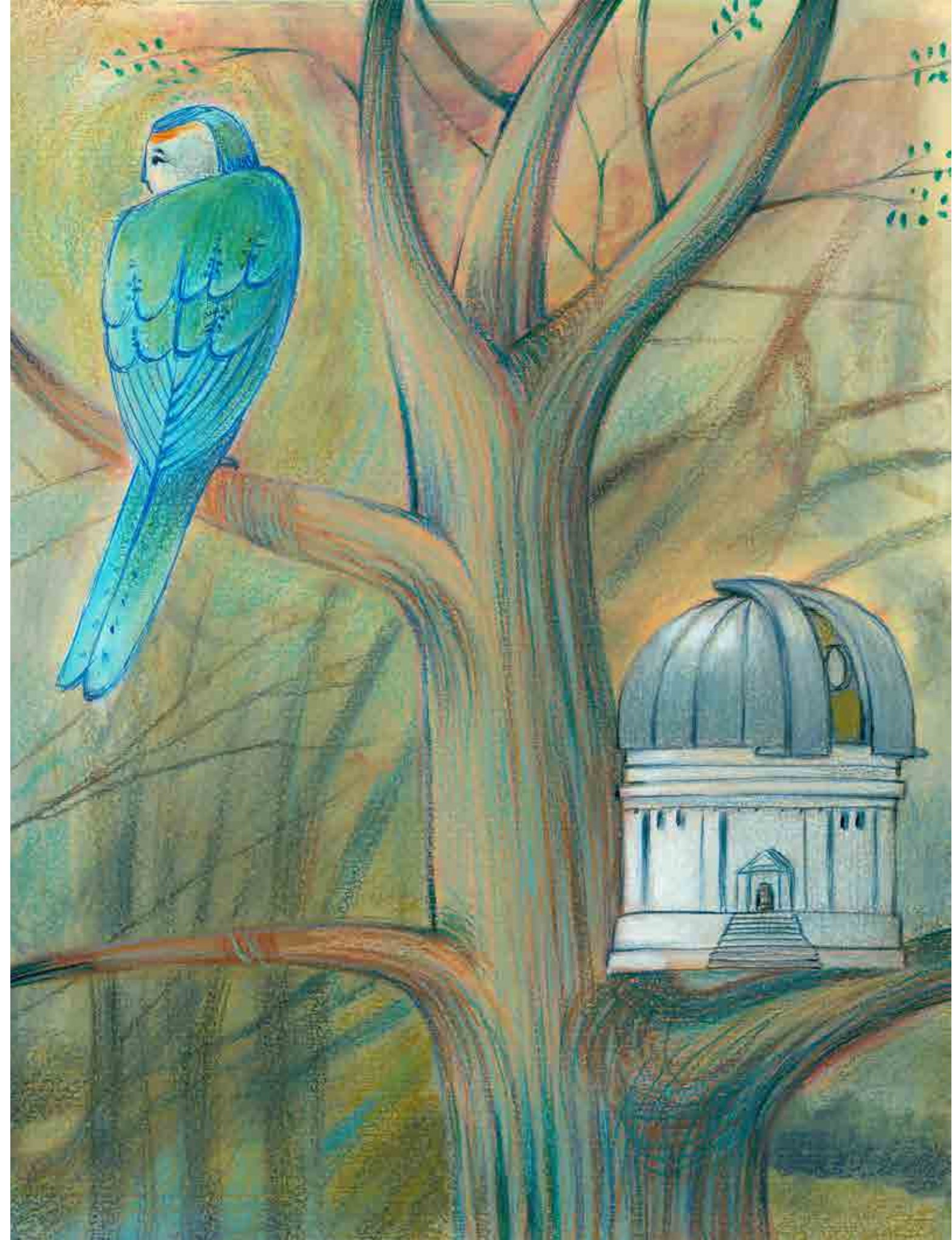




OWL CAME,
